

## AMERICAN BEECH (*Fagus grandifolia*)



American Beeches are suitable for medium to large areas. Their leaves emerge in the later part of the spring, are green to a dark green in the summer, and turn a golden bronze in the fall. The American Beech exhibits a slow growth rate, and prefers well-drained, aerated soil, as well as partial to full sun. The tree grows to a height of 50'-70' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 40'.
