

AUTUMNALIS CHERRY
(Prunus subhirtella)



Autumnalis Cherries are suitable for small to medium areas. Before foliage appears in the spring, the tree is covered in many semi-double, pink flowers, which may also appear in the fall. Their leaves are medium green in summer and are accompanied by small black berries. In fall, the leaves turn a light shade of yellow and brown. The Autumnalis Cherry exhibits a moderate to rapid growth rate, and prefers well-drained soil and partial shade to full sun. The tree grows to a height of 25'-35' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 35'.
