

BUR OAK
(*Quercus macrocarpa*)



Bur Oaks are suitable for large areas. Their leaves are green in summer and red in the fall. The Bur Oak exhibits a moderate growth rate, is tolerant of a good range of moisture and soil conditions, and prefers full sun. Bur Oaks adapt well to urban areas, live extended lives on average, and produce acorns that provide sustenance for area wildlife. The tree grows to a height of 70' to 80' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 80'.
