

**CAROLINA SILVERBELL**  
*(Halesia carolina)*



Carolina Silverbells are suitable for medium areas. Their leaves are green in summer and turn yellow in fall. They produce bell-shaped, white flowers and their bark is multicolored. The Carolina Silverbell exhibits a moderate growth rate, and prefers well-drained soil and partial to full sun. The tree grows to a height of 30'-40' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 35'.
