

CREPE MYRTLE
(Lagerstoemia indica)



Crepe Myrtles are suitable for small areas. The tree produces clusters of various shades of pink and red flowers that appear in mid-to-late summer. The leaves are dark green in summer, and turn dark purple in the fall. The Crepe Myrtle exhibits a moderate growth rate and prefers moist, well-drained soil and full sun. The tree grows to a height of 15'-20' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 15'.
