

FLOWERING DOGWOOD (*Cornus florida*)



White Flowering Dogwoods are suitable for small to medium areas. Their flowers are white in spring, their leaves are green in summer, and turn purple-red in the fall. Their glossy fruits attract winter birds. White Flowering Dogwoods exhibit a moderate growth rate, and prefer well-drained soil and partial shade. The tree grows to a height of 25' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 25'.
