

KOUSA DOGWOOD *(Cornus kousa)*



Kousa Dogwoods are suitable for small to medium areas. They produce white flowers in May and June, with dark green leaves in summer that turn purple and scarlet in the fall. The Kousa Dogwood exhibits a moderate growth rate, and prefers sandy or clay soil, and partial shade to full sun. The tree grows to a height of 15'-25' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 25'.
