

RED FLOWERING DOGWOOD



Red Flowering Dogwoods are suitable for small to medium areas. Their flowers are deep red, with green leaves in summer that turn bright scarlet in the fall. The Red Flowering Dogwood exhibits a moderate growth rate, and prefers well-drained soil and can do well in partial shade. The tree grows to a height of 15-30' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 20'.
