

SHUMARD OAK
(Quercus shumardii)



Shumard Oaks are suitable for moderate to large areas. Their leaves are dark green in the summer and turn brown to rustic red in the fall. The Shumard Oak exhibits a low to moderate growth rate, and prefers acidic, moist, well-drained soil, as well as full sun. The tree grows to a height of 40'-60' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 40'.
