

SOURWOOD
(Oxydendrum arboreum)



Sourwoods are suitable for small to medium areas. They produce fragrant white flowers in early summer, with green leaves that turn yellow, red, and purple in the fall. The Sourwood exhibits a slow growth rate, and prefers well-drained soil and full sunlight. The tree grows to a height of 25'-30' on average, with a canopy width of usually no more than 20'.
